REGISTRATION DATES:	Begins: May 15 th , 2018 – 8:00am Ends: May 18 th , 2018 – 12:00pm Teams MUST have three players on their roster before they can add to a specific division.
LEAGUES OFFERED:	Open Co-Rec
REGULAR SEASON:	<i>Begins on Monday, May 21st, 2018</i> The regular season will consist of 3 games over the course of 3 weeks.
FREE AGENTS:	Players looking for a team can attend a <i>Free Agent Meeting on Tuesday, May 15th @ 8:00pm</i> in the SWRC Skybox. Free Agent registration instructions can be found on our website under the “Find a Team” tab.
GAME SITES:	All games will be played on Southwest Recreation Center Courts 3-4.
GAME:	Games will consist of two 20 minute halves. The clock will stop during last one minute of the first half and the last two minutes of the second half.
MERCY RULE:	If a team is up by 35 or more points at any time in the second half or up by 20 or more points with two minutes or less remaining in the game, the game shall end. A team up by 20 or more points in the second half may not use full court pressure.
OVERTIME:	Overtime will only be used in the playoffs and will be explained on the Playoff Info Sheet.
TIMEOUTS:	Each team is permitted (2) one minute timeouts per game that may be used at any time. Coaches may call time-outs from the bench if they are checked in as a coach and may not be a player in the game.
FORFEITS:	Minimum of 3 players (4 for Co-Rec) are needed to start the game.
EQUIPMENT:	Teams must wear the same color shirt with a number at least three inches tall on the shirt (no taped numbers or written on skin. No hats or bandanas may be worn by any player on the court. No jewelry (including rubber bands) may be worn. Medical Alert tags may be worn, but must be taped down. BRING YOUR ALTERNATE WHITE JERSEYS TO EVERY GAME.
PLAYOFFS:	Competitive league teams earning a .500 or better record and 4.0 sportsmanship average or higher will be automatically eligible for playoffs. Teams which do not meet the record or sportsmanship requirements must e-mail the league coordinator by 10am the day after the regular season is completed in order to be considered for playoffs.
PLAYOFF SCHEDULES:	The Playoff Selection Draft will be held online on IMLeagues.com. Details will be emailed the final week of the regular season.
CHAMPIONSHIPS:	Intramural Sports Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winning team in the Open and Co-Rec divisions. A maximum of 10 shirts per team are permitted.
RULES REVIEW:	NFHS Basketball Rules (5-on-5) govern all rules not covered in Intramural Sports rules (http://www.recports.ufl.edu/images/uploads/docs/5-on-5_Basketball_Rules_2.pdf) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Substitutes must check in at the scorer’s table and be beckoned onto the court by an official. Penalty: First time: Warning, Subsequent Offenses: Technical foul • Players will foul out on their fifth personal foul. • Seven Team Fouls: 1 and 1 bonus, Ten Team Fouls: 2 shots • Once in possession in the backcourt, teams will have 10 seconds to get the ball into the frontcourt. Penalty: Violation • Slapping of the backboard without intent to block a shot will be a technical foul. • <i>During free throws, players in the lane spaces may not enter the lane until the ball is released and players outside the 3-point line may not come below the free throw line extended or inside the 3-point line until the ball has made contact with either the rim or backboard.</i> • Dunking during pregame is prohibited. Penalty: Technical Foul. Dunking during the game is acceptable. • It is a violation for a player in the frontcourt who is closely guarded (within 6 feet) to hold or dribble the ball for 5 seconds.
REGISTRATION PROCESS:	Registration opens Monday, May 15th, 2018 at 8:00am and will remain open until Friday, May 18th at 12:00pm. 1. Register your IMLeagues Account <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Go to https://www.recports.ufl.edu. b. Under the Intramural Sports tab, click on CAPTAIN’S MEETING AND REGISTRATION. c. Click the link for ONLINE REGISTRATION. d. Sign on using your gatorlink username and password. e. At the bottom of the page, click on the Intramural Sports IMLeagues graphic. f. Complete the required information and click Submit. g. Click the University of Florida link at the top of the page.

2. Signing Up A Team For An Intramural Sport

- a. Log in to your IMLeagues account using your gatorlink username and password.
- b. Click the **Create Team** button at the top right of your Use Homepage OR click on the **University of Florida** link and go to the school's homepage on IMLeagues.
- c. Select **5-on-5 Basketball** and the League and Division you wish to play in (if registration has not opened yet, you may organize your team in the Waitlist. Once registration opens you must log in and move your team from the Waitlist to desired Division).
- d. Click **Create Team**.
- e. View the "Captain's Training Video" embedded via YouTube and review 5-on-5 Basketball Sport Rules.
- f. Complete the "5-on-5 Basketball Captain's Quiz".
 - i. You must obtain a 100% on this quiz to be eligible to register. An unlimited number of attempts are allowed.
- g. Once you pass, enter all necessary information and click Submit.
- h. Teams must have 3 players on their roster before adding themselves to divisions.
- i. If registration has not opened and your team has been added to the waitlist, once league registration opens you must move your team to desired Division.
 - i. Log in to your imleagues.com account.
 - ii. Select your 5-on-5 Basketball team from the "Teams" section on your homepage.
 - iii. A red banner will appear at the top of the next screen prompting you to "click here" to view open spots in Divisions.
 - iv. Review open Divisions and select "Move to Division".

3. Joining An Intramural Sports Team

- a. Create a Team (for team captains only)
 - i. Invite members to the team
 - If team member has **already registered** on IMLeagues, search for his/her name and invite him/her, all invited members must accept the invitation to be added to your team
 - If team member is **not registered** on IMLeagues, scroll down to the "Invite by Email Address" box and input his/her email address.
- b. Join a Team
 - i. Click the orange **Join Team** icon button at the top of your homepage.
 - ii. Select **5-on-5 Basketball** and the League and Division which your desired team is registered.
 - iii. A list of teams playing in that division will load, select the team you wish you join by clicking the orange **Join Team** icon.
 - iv. Agree to the waiver and fill in all necessary information.
 - v. A message will be sent to the captain of the team you asked to join, once the captain has given approval you will be added to the roster.

You may organize your team early on the Waitlist (training, quiz, and adding team members). However, once registration opens you MUST move your team from the Waitlist to desired Division, otherwise your team will not be scheduled for play.
