- Respond to all emergency situations and adhere to established protocol including pre- and post-incident procedures
- All RecSports employees are expected to abide by the RecSports Student Staff Code of Conduct process that clarifies shared expectations and standards in effort to best serve our patrons, develop each team member, and prepare student employees for future career endeavors.

**Unit Specific Job Responsibilities**

- Responsible for smooth and efficient operations of two facilities totaling over 300,000 square feet.
- Provide Leadership by supervising anywhere from 2-8 Operations Associates on shift
- Ensure the proper opening and closing procedures of indoor and outdoor facilities and fields.
- Maintain safety and integrity of activity areas through policy enforcement
- Assist program participants and facility users regularly, on the phone and in person, with all aspects of the Recreational Sports Program. Make referrals to appropriate units as necessary. Be knowledgeable of all Recreational Sports and University programs.
- Regulate equipment room operations and staff coverage in various spaces.
- Respond to all injuries and assist in immediate first aid and proper emergency procedures.

**Requirements/Qualifications**

- First Aid, CPR, AED certification or ability to attain it within first week of employment
- Demonstrated communication, organizational, and leadership skills.
- Interest in recreation, fitness, and campus involvement
- Availability to work early mornings, nights, and weekend hours
- Availability to work three permanent shifts, at minimum, each week with flexibility to trade
- Complete and maintain UF online certifications in GET803, OOC101, PRV802, ITT102, GET811.
